
Non-Combustible Mantels on Gas Fireplaces

Each gas fireplace has a unique set of mantel requirements. If you wish to place a non-combustible mantel at a lesser height than specified in the manual, it will need to meet the following requirements:

- The header (the framing member above the fireplace opening) must be non-combustible.
- The facing must be non-combustible and extend to the header (or mantel, whichever is greater).
 The facing must also span the entire width of the mantel.
- See the illustration below for additional requirements.



NOTE: All other requirements listed in the installation manual must be followed.
