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Steel Mantel Shelf Assembly & Installation

Included Parts:

- (6) 2 1/2 inch wood screws
- (1) 3/16 inch drill bit

Additional Parts* NOT Included:

- metal self tapping screws or masonry tapcons * *not required*

Required Tools:

- power drill
- tape measure
- level
- Philips screw driver

Installation: *It is wise to have someone help you with this process.*

1. Separate the shelf backplate and the shelf top plate. Determine the area on your wall where you want to position your mantel shelf. Locate the studs in your wall - you may want to mark them with a pencil slightly higher than where you plan on installing your shelf.
2. Position the backplate under the stud marks on the wall. Use the level to establish a horizontal plane.
3. See **Figure 1**. Using the 3/16 inch drill bit provided and your power drill, bore through the backplate and into the wall. You can see in the picture where the 2 1/2 inch wood screws (provided) are then inserted through the drilled holes - approximately 1 inch from the top of the shelf backplate (just under the "overhang").
4. Using your Philips screw driver, secure the wood screws so that the backplate is stable. You may opt to use metal self tapping screws or masonry tapcons (not provided) in place of the wood screws that we have included.
5. See **Figure 2**. Place the rear of the shelf top plate onto the top of the shelf backplate. Slide firmly into place.

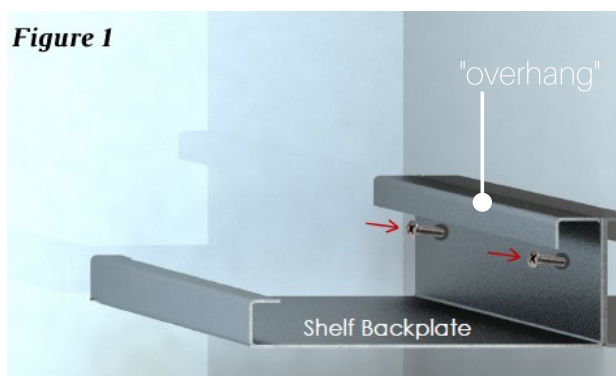
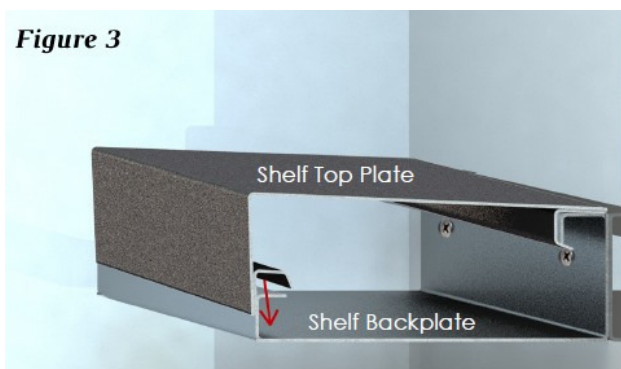

6. See **Figure 3**. Lower the front of the shelf top plate onto the front of the shelf backplate. Press firmly into place. Congratulations! You've installed your fireplace steel mantel shelf (see **Figure 4**)!
